**ORDER**

Vide reference read above, it has been decided to convert the Revision 2006 Diploma in Engineering/ Technology to credits Revision 2010 Diploma in Engineering/ Technology conversion, a candidate who has successfully completed in Revision 2006 scheme in a particular semester will be awarded to credit in accordance with the corresponding semester of Revision 2010 scheme on the basis of the marks, he/ she has earned. Hence sanction is accorded to convert mark system to CGPA and calculation of CGPA will be on the following bases.

$$\text{Total CGPA} = \frac{100}{95} \sum_{j=1}^n \frac{s_j c_j}{m_j} + \sum_{i=1}^n c_i G_i$$

Total credits of the Diploma Programme

where  $s_i$  = Total Marks Scored for a particular semester in Revision 2006

$m_j$  = Maximum mark for the particular semester in Revision 2006

$c_i$  = credit for the particular course in Revision 2010

$G_i$  = Grade point obtained by candidate for the course in Revision 2010.

Sanction is also accorded for converting CGPA system to mark system in 2010 Revision scheme, the following formula is to be used.

$$\text{Percentage of Marks} = \text{CGPA} \times 9.5$$


