SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME (SSP)

Part 2 /2 - Polytechnics (amount Rs 43 lakh)

(Head of Account - 2203-00-800-71- PLAN)

(Outlay Rs. 50 lakh)

For the implementation of Scholar Support Programme for the students of Engineering Colleges and Polytechnic Colleges, an amount of Rs 50 lakh is set apart in 2012-13. The beneficiaries are all candidates in Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics who are weak in academic standard. The scheme is for giving additional coaching to the needy students, to the subjects having more failure rate. A similar scheme is existing in Engineering Colleges which is exclusively for SC/ST students.

The department desires to implement the Scholar Support Programme which will benefit students of Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics who are academically weak. An amount of Rs. 43 lakh will be utilized for the implementation of the scheme in 43 Govt. Polytechnics @ Rs. 1 Lakh per Polytechnic. **This proposal for Rs. 43 lakh is for implementing Scholar Support Programme to the students of all the 43 Government Polytechnic Colleges.**

General Conditions

- (1) Remedial classes can be conducted to students of any semester based on the requirements of students, which will be decided by the Principal of the concerned Engineering College/ Polytechnic and upon availability of the fund allotted to institution.
- (2) Honorarium to faculty is fixed as Rs 600/hr in Engineering Colleges and Rs 250/hr for Polytechnic Colleges. Eminent faculty in the institutions and faculty from outside the
