A drone is an unmanned aircraft. Drones are more formally known as Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) or unmanned aircraft systems. Essentially, a drone is a flying robot that can be remotely controlled or fly autonomously using software-controlled flight plans in its embedded systems. UAVs were most often associated with the military. They were initially used for anti-aircraft target practice, intelligence gathering and, more controversially, as weapons platforms. Drones are now also used in a range of civilian roles including search and rescue, surveillance, traffic monitoring, weather monitoring, personal use, drone-based photography, videography, agriculture, delivery services etc. Drones have two basic functions: flight mode and navigation. To fly, drones must have a power source, such as battery or fuel. They also have rotors, propellers and a frame. The frame of a drone is typically made of a lightweight, composite material to reduce weight and increase maneuverability. Drones require a controller, which lets the operator use remote controls to launch, navigate and land the aircraft. Controllers communicate with the drone using radio waves, such as Wi-Fi.



	Cryptocurrency  Cryptocurrency is a digital payment system that doesn't depend on banks to verify transactions. It's a person to person system that can enable anyone anywhere to send and receive payments. Instead of carrying around and exchanging physical money in the real world, crypto currency payments are purely digital. When you transfer cryptocurrency funds, the transactions are recorded in a public ledger called blockchain. Cryptocurrency is stored in digital wallets.  Cryptocurrency received its name because it uses encryption to verify transactions. Encryption is the process of converting information or data into a code, especially to prevent unauthorized access. The aim of encryption is to provide security and safety.  The first cryptocurrency was Bitcoin, which was founded in 2009 and remains the best known today. Though there are thousands, the other most popular crypto currencies are Ethereum, Litecoin, Ripple etc. Units of cryptocurrency are created through a process called mining, which involves using computer power to solve complicated mathematical problems that generate coins. Users can also buy the currencies from brokers, then store and spend them using cryptographic wallets.  Transactions including bonds, stocks, and other financial assets could eventually be traded using the technology. Although Bitcoin has been around since 2009, cryptocurrencies and applications of blockchain technology are still emerging in financial terms, and more uses are expected in the future.
