III Draw plan, elevation and section of a stool in 1:20 scale, assuming suitable dimensions.

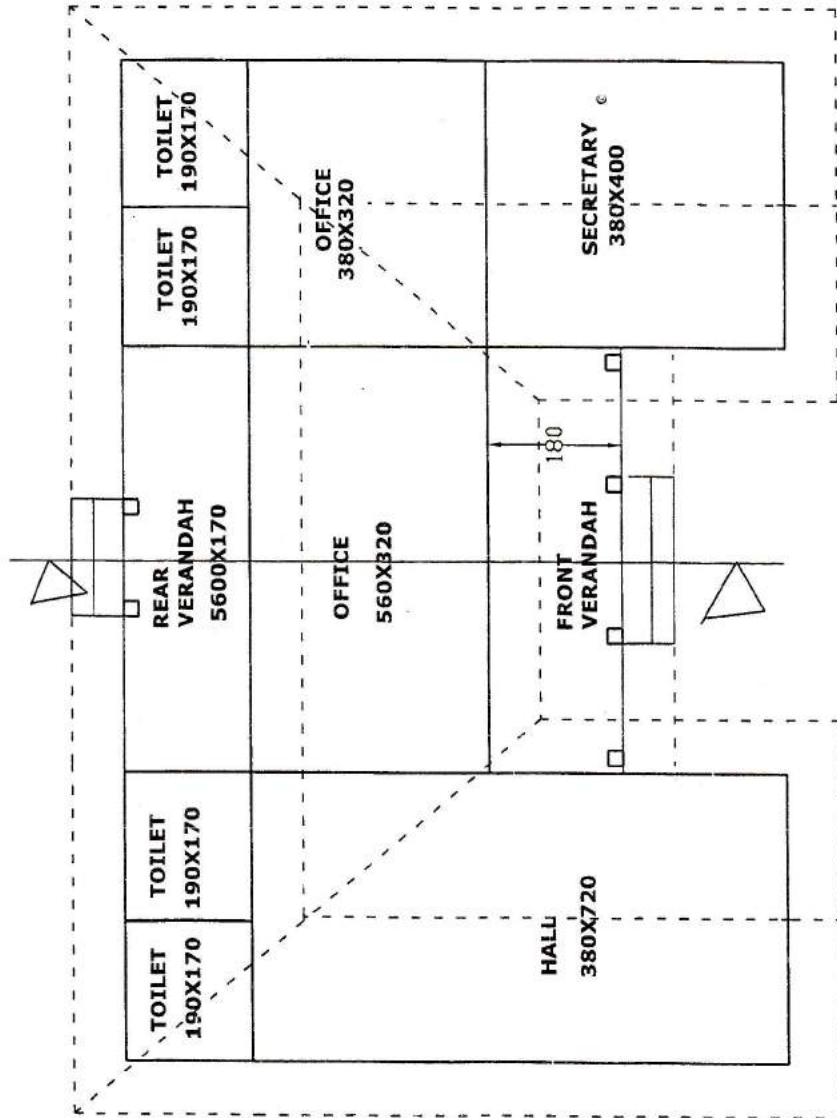
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PART—C
